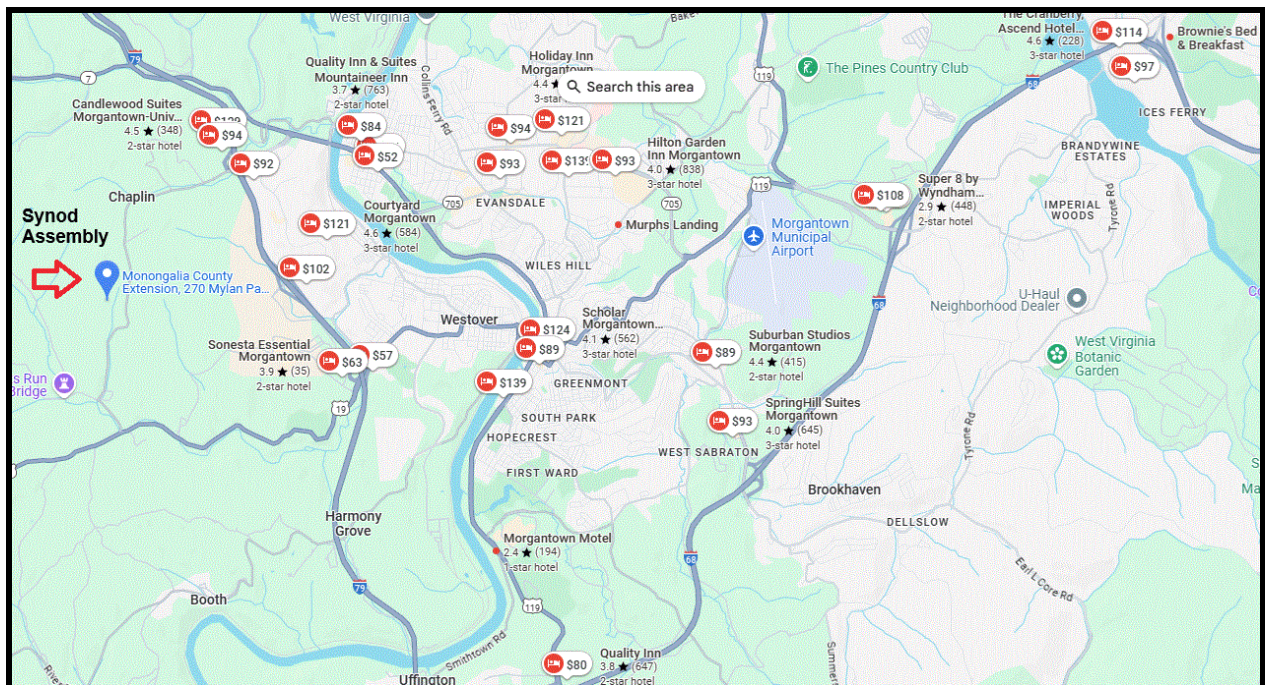


WV-WMD Synod Assembly: Lodging Guide

Lodging is not a requirement for Synod Assembly. As Synod Assembly is planned for one day, most will find it easy enough to drive to the assembly the morning of and drive home that evening. Some may still wish to come the night before and/or return home the day after. The greater Morgantown area offers plenty of lodging options should you decide to spend the night. **All lodging reservations and payments are the responsibility of the attendee. The synod does *not* provide lodging for the Assembly.**

The following list does not constitute an endorsement of any of the lodgings mentioned. Attendees are free to search for their own lodgings by other means.

Hotels & Motels



Several hotels and motels can be found in the Morgantown area (and even more as one drives south to Fairmont and Clarksburg), offering choices in terms of amenities, price, location, and neighborhood.

- As many people have memberships in one or more hotel chain rewards plans, the easiest way to search for a lodging within your plan is to use your plan's app or webpage. Our assembly will be held at Mylan Park. Select one of the following as the location:
 - Westover, WV
 - Star City, WV
 - Morgantown, WV

Bed & Breakfast etc.

RV Parks, Cabins, and Campsites

Nine miles away, Morgantown Campground offers both RV and tent sites at 57 Gamble Rd, Morgantown, WV 26501. Phone: 304-216-2844.

A little over twenty miles from Mylan Park (the vast majority of it by interstate), one finds two parks that offer both cabins and tenting:

- Coopers Rock State Park (<https://wvstateparks.com/park/coopers-rock-state-forest/>) and
- Chestnut Ridge Regional Park (https://www.monongaliacounty.gov/departments/parks_and_recreation/chestnut_ridge_park_and_campground/lodging.php).
